

## Report of the NCCP Committee to the NLJA 2014 AGM

Since the last NLJA AGM the following NCCP activities have been completed:

- ✓ Dojo Instructor Course for six people, June 2014, conducted by Tracy Angus
- ✓ Certification of a number of Dojo Assistant and Dojo Instructor coaches
- ✓ Succeeded in having Eileen Parsons accepted as a Canada Winter Games Apprentice Coach for the 2015 Canada Winter Games

We hope to conduct another Dojo Assistant Course in early 2015.

Those coaches who currently are “Trained” status should contact George to arrange for a practical review to achieve “Certified” status.

Looking forward an extremely important challenge for the NLJA is to grow its body of certified judo instructors, especially at the Competitor Development (old Level 3) level. This is the certification status required to coach at national tournaments and we only have three male coaches and **no** female coaches currently at this level. We need to develop a new generation of Comp Dev certified coaches before the next Canada Winter Games in 2019 or we won't be able to field a CWG Judo team. If you are interested in developing this certification do contact George.

The implementation of the requirement for continuing professional education to maintain qualifications has been delayed but should be implemented over the next year. A variety of activities can be used to meet the requirement for continuing certification but primary emphasis at this time is on courses already in the Coaching Canada database.
